Each half term I will send home a list of tasks via Seesaw. This half term I ask that you choose **4 from the list of 5** to complete. You can decide when to do these tasks, and in what order to complete them, but I expect them to be of a high standard. Please submit your work as a picture onto Seesaw for me to view each week on a Wednesday. Please put the number of the task you have chosen at the top of the page or have it written in a little blurb with your submission. I look forward to seeing your efforts!

Task 1	Research a Greek God and create a fact file or information text about them.	
Task 2	Show your knowledge of fractions and decimals on a poster or using power point.	
Task 3	Be inspired by a summer picture and write a short story related to it. Make sure to be creative and vary your sentence starters. The picture you choose could be researched or one that you have taken.	
Task 4	Make a model volcano and get it to erupt! (You can do this by filling a cup with a spoonful of baking soda. Then, slowly pour in enough vinegar to make the mixture foam up and flow out of the cup. This simulates an eruption and lava flowing out of your volcano.) https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=dIvXnqQaSwM Explain in writing why volcanoes erupt in the first place. Alternatively, if you don't want to give this experiment a go or don't have the resources, you can draw a picture of an erupting volcano to go with your writing!	
Task 5	Finish reading a good book this half term. When you complete it, design a new front cover for it and write your own blurb. Would you recommend it to a friend? Explain your reason. Can you persuade them to read it?
