Here are some ideas to help you vary your spelling practice at home.

Upper and Lower Write each of your words out two times. Write in uppercase the first time and lowercase the second time.	Fancy Letters Write each of your words in fancy writing. Your letters could be curly, dotty, or whatever you decide!	Spelling Flowers Draw a big flower. Write one of your spelling words on each petal.	Across and Down Write your words across and down, sharing the same first letter.
Curly Words Write out your words in your neatest handwriting. Then, write them again in curly letters.	Join the Dots Write each of your words using dots. Then, join the dots with a coloured pencil to make your word.	Backwards Words Write each of your words out forwards. Then, write them all backwards.	Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check! You know what to do!
Rainbow Words Write out your words with a pencil. Next, draw around each letter five more times using different coloured pencils.	Air Writing Write each of your words in the air with your finger. Ask someone to read your words as you write	Tell a Story Use all of your words to tell a short story. Underline each spelling word with a ruler and pencil	Scrabble Spelling Use scrabble tiles to spell your spelling words. Jumble up the letters and repeat! Alternatively, make your own with paper.
Pyramid Writing Write each of your words inside a pyramid. som some	Blue Vowels Write out each of your words. Then, go over the vowels in each word using a blue pencil.	ABC Order Write your words in alphabetical order.	Sentences Write sentences which include your chosen spelling words. Underline the words and say your sentences out loud.
