

# Spelling Practice Strategies

Here are some ideas to help you vary your spelling practice at home.

<p><b>Upper and Lower</b> Write each of your words out two times. Write in uppercase the first time and lowercase the second time.</p>	<p><b>Fancy Letters</b> Write each of your words in fancy writing. Your letters could be curly, dotted, or whatever you decide!</p>	<p><b>Spelling Flowers</b> Draw a big flower. Write one of your spelling words on each petal.</p>	<p><b>Across and Down</b> Write your words across and down, sharing the same first letter.</p> 
<p><b>Curly Words</b> Write out your words in your neatest handwriting. Then, write them again in curly letters.</p>	<p><b>Join the Dots</b> Write each of your words using dots. Then, join the dots with a coloured pencil to make your word.</p>	<p><b>Backwards Words</b> Write each of your words out forwards. Then, write them all backwards.</p>	<p><b>Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check!</b> You know what to do!</p>
<p><b>Rainbow Words</b> Write out your words with a pencil. Next, draw around each letter five more times using different coloured pencils.</p>	<p><b>Air Writing</b> Write each of your words in the air with your finger. Ask someone to read your words as you write.</p>	<p><b>Tell a Story</b> Use all of your words to tell a short story. Underline each spelling word with a ruler and pencil.</p>	<p><b>Scrabble Spelling</b> Use scrabble tiles to spell your spelling words. Jumble up the letters and repeat! Alternatively, make your own with paper.</p>
<p><b>Pyramid Writing</b> Write each of your words inside a pyramid.</p> 	<p><b>Blue Vowels</b> Write out each of your words. Then, go over the vowels in each word using a blue pencil.</p>	<p><b>ABC Order</b> Write your words in alphabetical order.</p>	<p><b>Sentences</b> Write sentences which include your chosen spelling words. Underline the words and say your sentences out loud.</p>
