English

This term we are going to use books related to our topic to inspire our writing, both fiction and non-fiction, including 'The Snail and the Whale', 'Emilia Earhart' and 'Meerkat Mail'. We have daily sessions to practise our handwriting and learn grammar rules, as well as spelling patterns that build on our phonics knowledge. We also have regular whole class guided reading sessions.

RE

We will look at places of worship for Christians and Muslims; their features, why they have these features and their similarities and differences.

History

We will be learning about the explorer Amelia Earhart and finding out about the early days of aviation.

Computing

First, we will look at programming and have a go at designing and testing robot algorithms. After half term, we will focus on data handling and look at tally charts, pictograms and block graphs.

Art

After a look at the artist Romare Bearden, and creating our own cityscape collages, we will be developing our skills in drawing, crafting, painting and art appreciation.

Science

For our topic of 'Animals, including humans', we will look at how offspring grow into adults and the basic needs of animals for survival. We will also explore healthy living and the importance for humans of looking after our bodies.

Travelling Around our Wonderful World



PE

PE will continue on a Wednesday and a Friday this term. We will start with units on invasion games and dance. After half term, our focus will be team building and gymnastics. Please ensure PE kits are in school at all times. Also, please remember that long hair needs to be tied back and earrings removed on PE days.

Maths

We begin the term with some work on money and then we will focus on multiplication and division, looking at the 2, 5 and 10 times-tables. After half term, we will also cover units on measurement (length, height, mass, capacity and temperature).

Geography

Music

We will have a go at copying rhythms and using percussion instruments to play the rhythms in time with music. We will also be learning a traditional Ghanaian call and response song.
