Task 1	PSHE – Drug Education Write the instructions for storing an using prescribed medication safely.
Task 2	Religion & Worldviews Draw a picture or make a model to depict the 10 plagues of Egypt.
Task 3	Geography – Volcanoes Draw or make a model of an active volcano. Make sure you clearly label the features we would expect to find.
Task 4	History – Ancient Greece Make a set of six Top Trump cards linked to Greek gods.
