Each half term we will send home a list of tasks via Seesaw. This half term we ask that you choose **6 from the list of 8** to complete. You can decide when to do these tasks, and in what order to complete them, but I expect them to be of a high standard. Please submit your work as a picture onto Seesaw for me to view each week on a **Wednesday**. Please put the number of the task you have chosen at the top of the page or have it written in a little blurb with your submission. I look forward to seeing your efforts!

Task 1	Create a fact file about robins. We'd like you to research them and write down some interesting facts. You could present this as a fact file or a simple non-fiction text. Draw, colour, or paint a picture of a robin to accompany it! Enjoy learning all about Robins!	
Task 2	Make a poster all about YOU! What makes you special? What interests do you have and what do you like? Who is in your family? You could tell us about an achievement or a hobby you have.	
Task 3	Research three musical instruments that the Romans played. Draw a picture and write one piece of information about each instrument. Which instruments would sound similar today? You might find this website helpful: https://melodyful.com/ancient-roman-musical-instruments	
Task 4	Find out about a Roman invention. What did the Romans do/make which shapes our lives today?	
Task 5	Using a world map, look up the population of 10 different countries of your choice. Colour them in and write their population. You could extend yourself about writing a fact about each country or looking up their national flag.	
Task 6	Research Septimius Severus and present it in any way you like. This is a Roman Emperor who we will not cover, but he had a significant impact on the Roman Empire.	
Task 7	Create a family and friends 'network' diagram. You could do this in the style of a family tree and then include friends separately. It is entirely your choice.	
Task 8	Please log in to your Times Table Rock Stars accounts. If you have any troubles, please contact the school office or speak to us directly. Complete 10 minutes a day, for 4 days straight!	

Your child should also be:
