Do you have some toy vehicles at home? Can you choose 2 or 3 and design an investigation to find out which car travels the furthest after going down a ramp? Let us know what you did and what you found out.

Task 3

Find a book that is special to you. Write some sentences to tell us why you like it and draw a picture of your favourite part.

Task 4



Make a musical instrument!

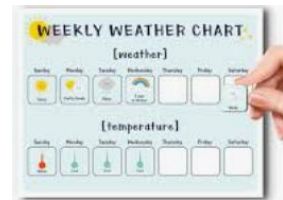
It could be one you pluck, hit or shake. Can you play along to different rhythms or maybe use it to keep a steady pulse?
